

DONATE before you discard!

CARPETS & RUGS

- Take to any Collection and Recycling Center and place in the YARD WASTE container; or
- Take to the Edmund Landfill's construction and demolition (C&D) landfill.

CLOTHES & BEDDING

- Bag and place in HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE.



State law bans **computers, computer monitors, printers, and televisions** from being disposed of in solid waste landfills (i.e. the garbage). These specific electronics **must** be recycled and may not be taken apart by residents for the purpose of recycling. (S.C. Code of Law, 48-60-05 et seq.)

ELECTRONICS (Computers, monitors, printers, TVs)

- Take up to five large items to the Edmund Landfill to be recycled at no charge; or
- Take to a local store such as Best Buy or Staples (if accepted, fee may apply); or
- Take to a Lexington County Recycling Drop-off Event.



ELECTRONICS (Other)

- See ELECTRONICS above for options; or
- If mostly metal, see SCRAP METAL; or
- If mostly plastic, see HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE.

FOOD



- Donate usable food to a food pantry.
- Give to a friend, co-worker or neighbor who can use it; or
- Compost it; or
- Place expired food in tightly sealed garbage bags in HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE.

FURNITURE (mostly metal)

- See "SCRAP METAL."

FURNITURE (wood/cloth)



- Take one pickup or trailer load to any Collection and Recycling Center and place in the YARD WASTE container; or
- Take any amount to the Edmund Landfill's construction and demolition (C&D) landfill.

HOUSEHOLD DECORATIONS

- Take to any Collection and Recycling Center and place in the YARD WASTE container; or
- Take to the Edmund Landfill's construction and demolition (C&D) landfill; or
- Place in your curbside garbage container.



HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

- Bag and place in your curbside garbage roll cart; or
- Bag and take to any Collection and Recycling Center and place in the HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE container; or
- Bag and take to the Edmund Landfill and place in the transfer station.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes materials with one or more of the following words on their label: **Caution, warning, danger, poison, flammable, combustible, corrosive.**

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE



- Take in liquid form to a Lexington County HHW drop-off event; or
- Dispose of small quantities in HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE, being careful not to mix too many different products in the same container and **never** to mix products containing bleach with those containing ammonia. A toxic gas can form!

KITCHEN APPLIANCES



- If mostly metal, see "SCRAP METAL."
- If mostly plastic, see "HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE."

KITCHEN DISHES

- Bag and place in HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE.

MATTRESSES & BOX SPRINGS

- Take to the Edmund Landfill to be recycled.

PAINT & STAIN

- Take up to eight gallons of liquid paint to a Lexington County HHW drop-off event (preferred method for hazardous oil-based paints and stains) or soak/dry it up **completely** with sand, kitty litter or other drying material and then discard in HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE using two trash bags. Liquid paint and stain easily causes expensive damage to containers, trucks, roads, cars, and more when compacted before reaching the landfill so it **must be completely dry before being discarded!**



PAPER & CARDBOARD

- Take to any Collection and Recycling Center and place in the OFFICE PAPER, MIXED PAPER or CARDBOARD container as appropriate; or
- Place in your curbside RECYCLING roll cart.

REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, & AC UNITS

- Take items with Freon (i.e. appliances that get cold) to the Edmund Landfill and pay a \$15 fee.
- Dominion customers may call 1-877-510-7234 to have **working** refrigerators picked up.

SCRAP METAL

- Take to any Collection and Recycling Center and lift up into the SCRAP METAL container; or
- Take to the Edmund Landfill and put in the SCRAP METAL pile on the ground.



Collection and Recycling Centers

Available to Lexington County residents for material brought from primary residence. Driver's license or other proof of residency may be required.

Curbside Recycling

Go to <https://lex-co.sc.gov> → Solid Waste Management to ensure that you place only materials accepted in your area in your curbside recycling roll cart.
